Rules and Code of Conduct

1. Please parallel park on both sides of the driveway, keeping the center open. Also, parking is available, below the new studio. Do not park in the spot closest to the house.
2. No smoking or foul language on the property, both indoors and outside.
3. Students must arrive on time for class as well as make every effort to attend all classes. Tardiness is very disruptive to the teacher and other students.
4. Upon arrival, students are to put their belongings on a hook above the bench and footwear neatly under the bench.
5. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children, while not in class. Students and other children must sit on the benches in the waiting room quietly when not in class. Students are not allowed to play or sit on the stairs, in waiting room of the house studios, as well as outside on the deck or any of the property.
6. Food is not permitted in both the Waiting area and Dance Studios. Students can bring water to drink for their break.
7. Students/parents are responsible for their own belongings. The dance teachers and studio owner is not responsible/liable for any lost or stolen items on the property where lessons are, as well as any other performance location, including the annual recital.
8. Students must wear the required outfit (refer to dress code) for every class. For recital and photos students are prohibited from adding items or taking away items from their costumes, i.e. extra headpiece.
9. No cell phones allowed in class. Besides being disruptive, it distorts the sound system.
10. Students and teachers only, are allowed to enter the dance rooms.
11. Please do not address the teachers with concerns before or after class, as they are teaching classes back to back and don't have time to talk. However, feel free to email or call them.
12. Dancing with tap shoes on, is not permitted on the Waiting room floor.
13. Parents/Guardians must inform teachers of any behavioural disorder, i.e. ADHD, along with any medications being taken.
14. We reserve the right to dismiss any student from classes, if their behaviour causes too much disruption and and if they pose a threat to others in the class. Every effort to change this behaviour will be made first.
15. Students may not be able to continue with classes if class fees and fundraising amounts owed are not paid within the time frame agreed upon.
16. All dance class fees paid and fundraising amounts collected are non-refundable.
17. We reserve the right to not offer any class where the minimum enrollment is not met.
